

**SUMMARY OF MINUTES OF HUNTSVILLE TOWN COUNCIL MEETING
HELD MARCH 6th, 2008

- The Council passed a motion to hold a work session in conjunction with the planning commission on March 27th @ 6:30 p.m. to hear a power point presentation by Danny Mason about a village development concept.
- The Council passed a motion to deny D-Bell's request that the town vacate the road at the west end of 300 south.
- The Council passed a motion to send a letter to the Weber County School District. This letter is in regards to Valley Elementary leaving Huntsville Town and relocating in Eden. One of items discussed in the letter is the alleyway that the town deeded to the school district on the north part of the school block. If this property is ever sold the town wants it deeded back. The second item is, that just prior to learning about the re-model of the elementary school, council members met with the school board and school principal, to see what the town could do to help expedite the process of the re-model. At that time the roadways and parking in front of the school were a big concern. The town paved the road in front of the school from curb to curb, at a cost of \$42,000.00. The council feels that the town should ask to be reimbursed for this expense.
