

WORK SESSION—MAY 20th, 2010

Discussion on proposed Toll Road:

Mayor Truett called the meeting to order and explained that this work session is being held so the council can finalize issues relative to the tollbooth. The Mayor has been calling people in town to see if they were interested in manning the booth. We don’t want teenagers in the booth because the situation could be volatile. Operating hours were discussed, weekdays 11:00-8:00 p.m. and weekends 8:00 a.m.-8:00 p.m. CM Ferre’ asked what type of ticket or pass is going to be to be handed out. CM Clapperton showed an example of a season pass that could be hung on your rear view mirror. A day pass would look more like a ticket to put on your dash board. People heading to the cemetery will not be charged. Each pass will be numbered; the attendant will keep track of the passes sold during each shift. There should be checks and balances. Passes should be numbered and receipt stub should balance with what is in the till. There will be a log from each employee. The day passes will be written on with a different colored marker each day.

CM Ferre’ suggested having a season pass for \$30.00, and a day pass for \$3.00. The Ogden Boat Club, Club Rec., AL&L, and Forest Service employees will not be charged to go through the tollbooth. Sandy brought up the idea of placing the town’s booth right up close to AL&L’s booth, there is a turnaround area and it would be past any residential homes. The logistics of having the booth at 6800 E. is good, but how is the town going to deal with all the home owners that live past it. The home owners will be placed on a list just like the boat club. Sandy mentioned that there are 35 members at the Ogden Boat Club, they park their trailer and come up every weekend. They will be given 70 annual passes, two passes per member.

Mayor Truett made a motion to adjourn. CM Clapperton seconded. All votes aye. Motion passed.
