The Huntsville green waste facility will open for the season beginning

Saturday, April 3, 2010  
from 10 AM - 2 PM

It will remain open on Saturdays throughout the summer and early fall. When demand warrants, the facility will also be open on Wednesday evenings. The green waste facility accepts YARD WASTE ONLY:

Accepted Materials include woody tree materials, vines, bushes, twigs, and limbs.  
**Compost material**- (soft, unbagged, vegetative material) grass clippings, leaves, pine needles, sawdust, and shavings, etc.

There is a \$5 fee per load to help offset the costs associated with the facility, but you can save money by purchasing a punch card.

Huntsville Residents Fees:  
\$5.00 per load  
5-day pass \$20.00

Non-Huntsville Residents Fees:  
\$10.00 per load (single axle truck or trailer)  
\$40.00 per ton  
5-day pass \$40.00
