## Your Town At Work

Last fall, while the town council was engaged in searching out cost savings measures, Councilman Alan Clapperton suggested that we install a natural gas line to the water purification plant. To do this, 2,060 feet of gas line would need to be installed at a total cost of \$10,345. Natural gas is substantially cheaper than propane (\$0.72/gallon for natural gas) and it was estimated that the \$10,345 cost could be recouped in less than three years with the cost savings.

For the previous 34 months, our propane costs have averaged \$392/month. The gas line project was completed recently and three neighbors have also hooked on to the natural gas line. For each hookup, the town receives \$640, so we expect to recoup the project cost even sooner.
