Your Town At Work

Last fall, while the town council was engaged in searching out cost savings measures, Councilman Alan Clapperton suggested that we install a natural gas line to the water purification plant. To do this, 2,060 feet of gas line would need to be installed at a total cost of \$10,345. Natural gas is substantially cheaper than propane (\$0.72/gallon for natural gas) and it was estimated that the \$10,345 cost could be recouped in less than three years with the cost savings.

For the previous 34 months, our propane costs have averaged \$392/month. The gas line project was completed recently and three neighbors have also hooked on to the natural gas line. For each hookup, the town receives \$640, so we expect to recoup the project cost even sooner.

Chipped Wood Mulch Now Available

Chipped Wood is now available at the Green Waste Facility (aka The Dump).

Here are the prices for mulch:

Town residents - \$10/pickup load or two punches on your punch pass

Out of town residents - \$20/pickup load or two punches on an out of town pass

\$15 a yard **loaded** – 5 yard minimum (5 yard minimum may be combined with your neighbors)

Call 801-745-3420 to coordinate loading.

Prices to dump green waste:

\$5/load for in town residents (or one punch on your punch pass)

\$10/load for out of town residents (or one punch on your punch pass)

Punch pass Prices:

In town - \$20 for 5 punches

Out of town - \$40 for 5 punches

A punch pass gives you an extra dump - (Five punches for the price of four dumps).

It also allows you to make multiple dumps in a day.

****VOTER** REGISTRATION**

General Election Day is
November 8, 2011.

To register to vote you must: 1-Be a citizen of the U.S., 2- Have resided in Utah for 30 days immediately before the next election, 3- Be at least 18 years old on or before the next election.

If you are not yet registered to vote in this year's upcoming General Elections, you can do so by using the following methods:

How do I register to vote?

Online: @ www.elections.utah.gov. Download and print a [Utah Voter Registration Form](#). Once completed, mail the form to your [county clerk's office](#) @ Weber County Clerk's Office, 2380 Washington Blvd, Ogden, 84401. Include a photocopy of your driver's license or another form of picture identification with the registration form. Must be postmarked 30 days before the general election (November 8th) to be registered for the upcoming election.

Phone Book: There is also a voter registration form in The Dex Phone Book (located on page 43). This form can be photocopied. Once completed, it should be mailed to your [county clerk's office](#) @ Weber County Clerk's Office, 2380 Washington Blvd. Ogden, UT 84401, before October 9th. Include a photocopy of your driver's license or another form of picture identification with the registration form; otherwise you will be required to present this information at the polls.

In-Person Registration: The last day the county clerk can take an in-person registration is October 24th. A person may register to vote in-person @ 2380 Washington Blvd., Ogden, UT.

Absentee Voter Ballot:
The last day to request an Absentee Voter Ballot is November 4th. To request an Absentee Voter Ballot, call the Weber County Election Office @ 801-399-8034. ***For Huntsville Town Residents please contact Gail Ahlstrom @ 801-745-3420. Huntsville Town has opted to NOT hold early voting. If you want to vote early you can do so by Absentee Ballot.***

Drivers License & State Agency Offices: Registration forms are also available at State Agency Offices, including the Drivers License Division, Division of Workforce Services, Utah State Department of Health, Women, Infant and Children (WIC) Offices, the Division of Services for People with Disabilities, the Department of Rehabilitation, and public colleges and universities.

There is new legislation for the elections that requires a two week early voting period. Watch for more information on this issue. Please contact the Weber County Elections Office @ 801-399-7411 with any election or voting questions. Huntsville Town has opted to NOT hold early voting.
