Are your Dogs Licensed?

We know there are a percentage of Weber County employees that are unaware that licensing their dogs is a requirement and for some, based on the city you live in, licensing a cat is required. Licensing is annual for Weber County/Ogden area. You will need to provide current rabies vaccination records at the time you are licensing.

We have provided a list of cities to help you get your dogs/cats licensed:

Farr West, Harrisville, Hooper, Huntsville, Marriott/Slaterville, Plain City, West Haven, Unitah and unincorporated Weber County all dogs must be licensed. Washington Terrace City all *dogs and cats* must be licensed. You must license your pet with Weber County Animal Services.

If you live in Ogden City call the Ogden City Cashier at (801)629-8244 or go to the Ogden Municipal Building at 2549 Washington Blvd. on the 2nd floor or the Parks and Recreation Bldg. at 1845 Monroe Blvd. to license all *dogs and cats*.

If you live in Roy City call Roy City Animal Control at (801)774-1076. You license at the city office at 5050 S. 1900 W., Roy.
