

## **\*\*VOTER REGISTRATION\*\***

If you are not yet registered to vote in this year's upcoming General Elections, you can do so by using the following methods:

### **How do I register to vote?**

**Online:** @ <http://elections.utah.gov/voterregistrationinformation.html>. Download and print a Utah Voter Registration Form. Once completed, mail the form to your county clerk's office @ Weber County Clerk's Office, 2380 Washington Blvd, Ogden, 84401. If possible, include a photocopy of your driver's license or another form of picture identification with the registration form. Must be postmarked 30 days before the general election (November 3<sup>rd</sup>) to be registered for the upcoming election.

**Phone Book:** There is also a voter registration form in The White Pages (located at the end of the blue government section). This form can be photocopied. Once completed, it should be mailed to your county clerk's office @ Weber County Clerk's Office, 2380 Washington Blvd. Ogden, UT 84401, before October 5<sup>th</sup>. If possible, include a photocopy of your driver's license or another form of picture identification with the registration form; otherwise you will be required to present this information at the polls.

**In-Person Registration:** The last day the county clerk can take a in-person registration is October 19<sup>th</sup>, a person may register to vote in-person @ 2380 Washington Blvd., Ogden, UT.

**Drivers License & State Agency Offices:** Registration forms are also available at State Agency Offices, including the Drivers License Division, Division of Workforce Services, Utah State Department of Health, Women, Infant and Children (WIC) Offices, the Division of Services for People with Disabilities, the Department of Rehabilitation, and public colleges and universities.

The last day to request an Absentee Voter Ballot is October 30<sup>th</sup>. To request an Absentee Voter Ballot, call the Weber County Election Office @ 801-399-8034. There is new legislation for the elections that requires a two week early voting period. Watch for more information on this issue.
